



Woodland Wedding Information Sheet

- 1 There is no charge to hold a Woodland Wedding, but the site is completely “dry hire”. This means we do not set it up, manage the Ceremony for you and we will not collect any of your belongings, flowers or props you may add to the site
- 2 Access to the site is immediately following the last ceremony, even if a wedding is taking place as it is totally unseen from The Barn and garden etc
- 3 Please give careful consideration to access for the bride and for all guests, especially elderly and children
- 4 Wheelchair and pushchair access will be very difficult as the parking is in a field (weather permitting) and the path is woodchip. All surfaces are uneven and real farming fields with cow pats etc!
- 5 Footwear must be sensible – we will not accept any complaints from ladies (or gents!) in heels!
- 6 Insects.....woods have flies, horseflies, gnats and other annoying insects! Of course, there are also birds and butterflies to compensate!
- 7 Seating is limited. We will have benches which will accommodate up to 45 bottoms, but guests could be encouraged to bring picnic chairs and rugs?
- 8 For decoration suppliers please refer to the Venue Information on the website
- 9 You need to inform your photographer and florist as there may be extra costs from them
- 10 Our advice would be to keep it simple!
- 11 Music to accompany the ceremony is strictly live acoustic only i.e. nothing that requires electricity or batteries and needs a speaker
- 12 Conductor of The Ceremony! You can arrange anyone you like to conduct the ceremony and however you wish, but if you would like an official to do this for you please refer to the list of Humanist and Celebrants in the Venue Information on our website
- 13 Sorry to be negative but you must have a wet weather back up plan! This would be the Ceremony taking place in The Barn, but a decision must be made by 5pm on the day of the previous event at The Barn in the busy summer period
