1.142 guests - Maximum

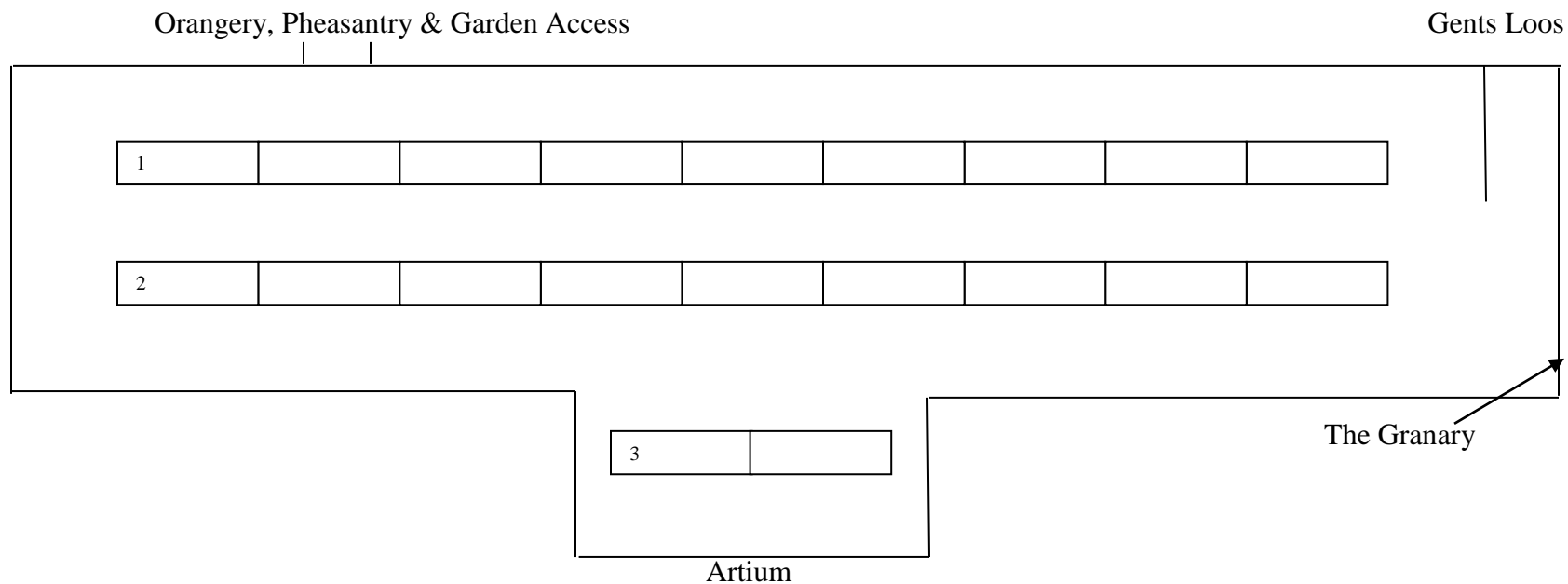


Table 1 – 9 x 3ft by 6ft trestle tables – 33 guests one side & 32 guests the other side

If you would like 150 guests 2 x 5ft 6in round tables will need to replace the 2 x trestle tables in The Atrium seating 10 guests on each

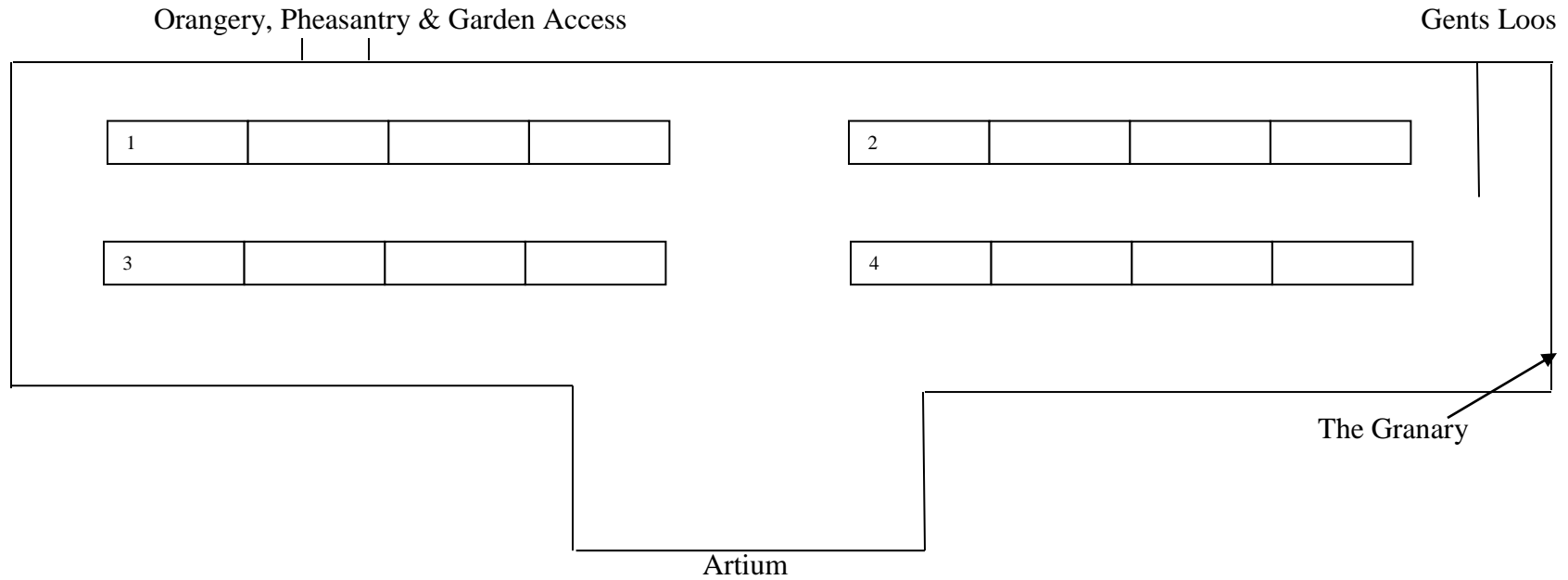


Table 1 – 4 x 3ft by 6ft trestle tables – 14 guests one side & 14 guests the other side

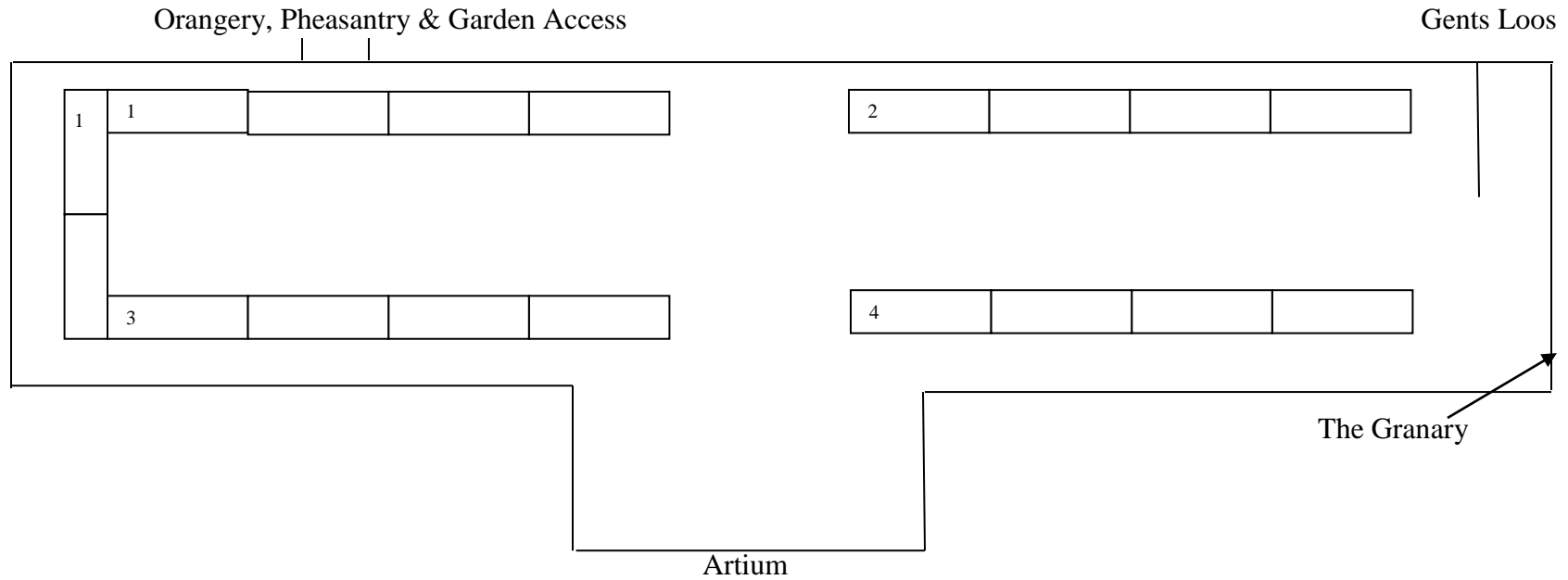

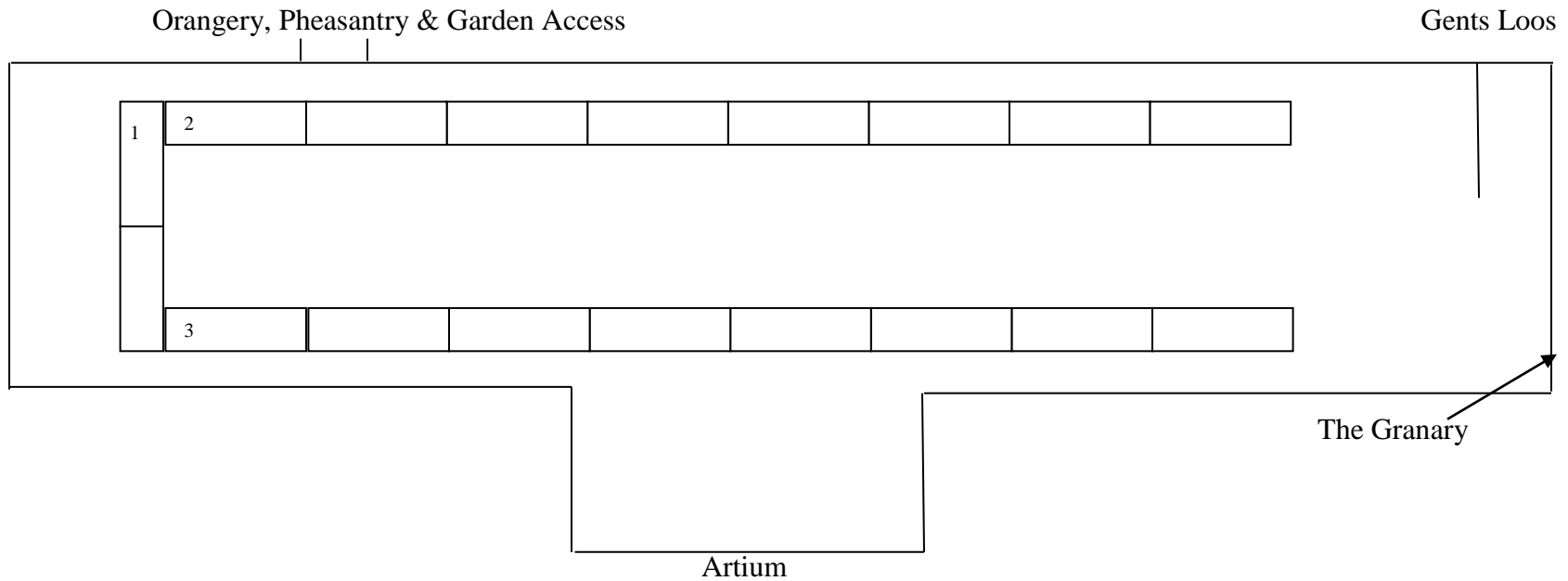


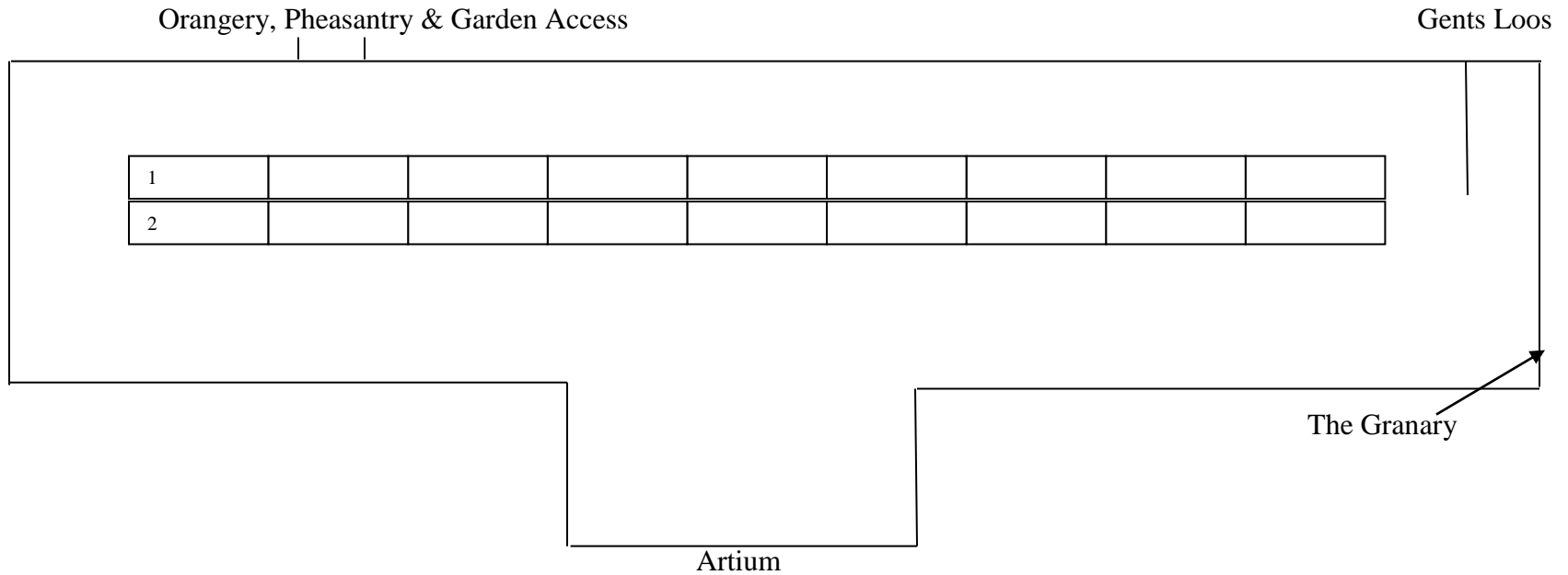
Table 1 – 2 x 3ft by 6ft trestle tables – 6 guests
