



EVENING FOOD

Evening Food can be provided so long as it does not involve using the kitchen in any way for refrigeration or heating food. Examples of evening food which would fall into this category would be kettle chips and nuts, dried or fresh fruit or a sweetie table.

Couples can also hire a self-contained sub contractor such as a Fish & Chip van, Cornish pasty van, pizza delivery or ice cream tricycle. These contractors do not need to use the GSB kitchen and have their own licenses. You will need to agree arrangements for disposable plates, napkins etc with GSB.

All other evening food including cheeseboards **MUST** be ordered through the caterer. If you wish to supply your own cheese, this is something you have to discuss with the caterer so that they are responsible for putting out the cheeseboard and any plates and cutlery required.

Couples often require their cake to be cut and put on a platter for evening food. This is something you need to agree with your caterer. If they are providing staff for evening food then the timing of cutting the cake will not be critical. However, if there is no evening food you will need to cut the cake before they leave having cleared up the Main Barn so that they are still on site to plate up the cake.

Some bands will require a crew meal in the evening and this is something you need to discuss with your caterer.
